After a standard Prayer, I put the greatest Commandment into practice; after I do what is Commanded [and more than what is Commanded] of me, I Thank God, Whom I Love, For Jesus His Son; then, I express my Love To Jesus and Communicate Prayerfully and fairly Openly. I Thank and Love God and Jesus For The Holy Spirit, and then I Love The Holy Spirit and Its Purity and Grace. I Thank God for the different things He Has [and Had] Done for me since I last Prayed. I Ask Him To Forgive my sins (inclusive of wrongs and mistakes against His Kingdom, other people, and myself). I let God Know [put effort into] that I forgive from my heart those who have wronged me. I Ask God To Help me with the things I am to do with His Kingdom, my job, family, etc.. Finally, I express my Love simply To God, Jesus, and The Holy Spirit.

Asking Jesus and The Holy Spirit To Help, too. Did it for about a year without Asking for Their Help (except in my spirit) and much better now.

I hope this helps you, [I say] a standard Prayer is said first. This

thou shalt not hearken unto the words of that prophet, or that dreamer of dreams: for **The Lord** your **God** Proveth you, To Know whether ye Love **The Lord** your **God** with all your heart and with all your soul. Ye shall walk After **The Lord** your **God**, and Fear **Him**, and keep **His** Commandments, and obey **His** Voice, and ye Shall Serve **Him**, and Cleave Unto **Him**.

helps to [automatically] attune myself With **God**, no matter what mood I may be in. In my case using **The Lord**'s Prayer, but not with words that can be rambled off, but can be said with thoughtful and Prayerful meaning is helpful. For this I combine **The Lord**'s Prayer of <u>Matthew</u> 6:9-13 and Luke 11:2-4 from the recent Good News Bible.

Different theologians: Heart is sometimes referred to as soul.

When establishing my Love To **God** from my heart, I, then, open up my heart completely Loving **Him** with all of my heart.

After establishing my complete mind in Loving God, I Love Him with all my mind.

I presently do this with an address (if I think of it or The Lord's Prayer), The Lord's Prayer (using "I" versus "Our", etc., and using the Good News Bible translation), then Loving God through the greatest Commandment and beyond, then, Thanking God Lovingly for Jesus (and Loving Jesus with Thanks & Praying To Him), and then Thanking God and Jesus for The Holy Spirit (and Loving The Holy Spirit (understanding Its Purity)), then Thanking God for the different things since the last time I Prayed, then Asking Him To Forgive me for my sins (including offenses, mistakes, etc.), and can Ask For Jesus To Come Into my heart; and, a general and detailed forgiveness on my part for those who have wronged me, and then finishing up Asking

For this commandment which I command thee this day, it is not hidden from thee, neither is it far off. It is not in heaven, that thou shouldest say, Who shall go up for us to heaven, and bring it unto us, that we may hear it, and do it? Neither is it beyond the sea, that thou shouldest say, Who shall go over the sea for us, and bring it unto us, that we may hear it, and do it? If I run into trouble Praying To **Yehovah** at this point, I Ask **Jesus**, **The Messiah** and **The Holy Spirit** To Help me, and Graciously **They** Do, continually Loving **God** with my spirit, I, then, Love **Him** with all my spirit.

[Loving God combining all activated stages of my being.]

Him. With these two together, I also, Love God with all of my soul, combining it with all my spirit and strength. I open all my heart and Love God with all my heart combining with all my soul, strength, and spirit. Then, I go to my brain, both subconscious and conscious, and Love God openly and combine that Love with my Love from all my heart, soul, strength, and spirit. Then, and at once, I Love God, my Father with all of my entire being.

[We should always [try] from the start to (try to) Love **God** with <u>all</u> [of each part].]

There were months when I did not Love God with my "all" level

And yet they would not hearken unto their judges, but they went a whoring after other gods, and bowed themselves unto them: they turned quickly out of the way which their 'daddies' walked in, obeying the Commandments Of **The Lord**; but they did not so.

The hardest time I've had doing this is when I was impatient.

The given exercise of the greatest Commandment itself, is now taking less time to do but with more power.

The best time to do this method is a time in the day when I feel I am most alert.

The general idea & feeling of Loving with all of our beings is one thing, putting it into detailed practice is another.

It will, also, bring you closer To **God**. You should be able to notice different things About **God** while doing it.

I hope you take this with positive action and is an aid for [you as constructive guidelines for] your present & future With God.

I hope this does not confuse you but positively aids you.

We have to penetrate the mysteries surrounding **God**'s Infinity by a concentrated effort in Loving **Him**.

After I start Loving God, I Ask Him To Clean out my heart, mind, soul and inner being, strength, and spirit of any impurities, which may or would cause a block in my Loving Him.

- 1. Loving **God** with all of "my", "your", "the" heart. The definition of heart is referred to like the Samaritan's heart in <u>Luke</u> 10:33 .., his heart was filled with pity. (<u>Good News Bible</u>) Heart is sometimes referred to as soul.
- 2. Loving **God** with all of "my", "your", "the" mind. Here is a plus to Love **God** with the entire mind: both the conscious and subconscious (example for subconscious: memory of past Relationships With **God** and **His** and your Love).

- Loving God with all of "the", "your', "my" soul and inner being. 3. Many Bibles do not have spirit listed with the parts we are to Love God with in the first Commandment. The dictionary, through the definitions, portrays soul as the spiritual part of man. Some Churches consider soul and spirit basically synonymous, while others consider the soul and the spirit separate. Soul, here, is treated separate though related with the spirit. The soul and inner being are connected but each distinct. The two are combined with this step, because it is easier with their relation. The soul is used as the vibrant living depths of an individual (much like or containing the "solid" character of the individual versus the looser, socially adaptable personality). In Loving God with the inner being is like Loving God with all of the inside organs in the way of Loving with the heart, another words, there is more to it than just generating Love from the "organs" and inner self. With Loving God with the "soul" and "inner being" combined, Loving God, The Father, from the inner part of the being from the feet to the top of the body is more complete. As you have and will notice, I believe the treatment and practicing of adding even more to the greatest Commandment is not subtracting from the most important Commandment [, as progressing indicated in the Holy Scriptures]. The more we Love God with -- the better.
- 4. Loving God with all of "my, "your", "the" strength. Here the fingers are interlaced in a grip for Praying and all of the muscles are

tightened to their maximum possible strength, Loving God, and directing all of the strength to Loving God.

Loving God with all of "your", "the", "my" spirit. The American 5. College Dictionary variably defines spirit as "the principle of conscious life" . . . "mediating between body and soul"; "the incorporeal part of man"; "the soul as separable from the body at death"; "the divine influence as an agency working in the heart of man"; "the dominant tendency or character of anything" . . . "Syn. life, mind, consciousness". The preceding definitions were not placed for incoherency, but for understanding the spirit with pinpoints, width, depth, and infinite height. Likewise, you may see why I add spirit to the first Commandment. "Spirit" is defined above with "soul", "heart", and "mind". It, also, interconnects different parts of the being. The spirit of the human being is shown as, also, existing supernaturally, undefinable mathematically, and superior to other parts of the being. There are, of course, more definitions of spirit than the ones listed above: however, the point is why I add spirit to the greatest Commandment, even though Loving God, my Father, with my "soul" is part of it, too; but, Loving with the "spirit", also, is Loving even more, and that is implied in the Commandment, itself, to go further than required. Physically speaking [and not easy to define], my soul But **The Lord** Said Unto Samuel, Look not on his countenance, or on the height of his stature; because I Have Refused him: for **The Lord** Seeth not as man seeth; for man looketh on the outward appearance, but **The Lord** Looketh On the heart.

is my full being with depth, even though separable from other parts of my being and my spirit to be located on the outer layer of me and seems to be very pure. When Loving **God** with my spirit, that outer part of me moves in a freer sense. As you progress with the greatest Commandment, you will probably have greater & newer perception at this step. In summary, for clarity, the part of the being in step 3 represents the overall and depths of the individual, where this step has the outer, unlimited part of the individual.

- 6. Loving **God** with all of "the", "your", "my" spirit and strength combined. All of the spirit and all of the strength in Loving **God** are blended and combined to one force.
- 7. Loving **God** with all of "the", "your", "my" spirit, strength, and soul and inner being combined. Starting with Loving **God**, **The Father**, with all of the soul and inner being, combining it with the Love from all of the strength, and adding the Love from all of the spirit.
- 8. Loving **God** with all of "the", "my", "your" heart, soul, and inner being, strength, and spirit. Establishing all of the heart in Loving **God** and powered together with Loving **God** with all of the spirit.
- 9. Loving God with all of "the", "your", "my" spirit, strength, soul and inner being, heart, and mind. Instead of being placed second to

The greatest Commandment was delayed for almost four months with very little successful activity (could be **God** Coordinating this project with and project in **His** Kingdom)

Had my son help me by him being there while I did it.

If I feel inadequate in doing the greatest Commandment in the beginning parts, it does help to go ahead with it & pick up on the latter parts of combining of my being in Loving God.

I got out of the successful habit of doing it from January until May of 1979.

I began this adventure in 1977.

But Jehu took no heed to walk in the law Of **The Lord God** of Israel with all his heart: for he departed not from the sins of Jeroboam, which made Israel to sin.

I added my spirit (defined as the outer, living, pure, invisible part of me that I feel) to Loving God, and found that I was best able to associate my spirit and produce love through it in a humble, Prayer position, with my arms outstretched over the bed with my head in a face down type position. It has been in Loving God, my Father, with the spirit of my being that infinity has opened up more than in Loving God with other parts of my being.

I began directing my total mind (conscious and subconscious mind inclusive) to Loving **God**, after weeks of practice, starting with the conscious and subconscious mind separate.

The greatest power of Loving God with all of my heart was when my heart (not the organ!) was out of the front part of my body (another words my heart was not limited to my mortal being). Most of the time "with all of my heart" is Loving God with all of my heart with no restrictions -- obvious or sublimely. I remember that the responsive Love From God seemed to me to be too much for me to cope with during some of the times that I Loved God with all of my heart, but this was due to my ignorance and lack of purity. A similar effect with all of my mind occurs but with a portion of my mind out of my body. My soul is filled with warmth & "feeling" love, which seems alive itself when Loving God with all of my soul. My strength feels secure when

Loving God with all of my strength. My spirit becomes beautifully enveloped when Loving God with all of my spirit. When combining the different parts of my being with the "all" of each a more powerful, gentle Love occurs.

As Christians we should take a clear look at the greatest Commandment, and not let the cloudiness of the past and not let the irrationality of rationalizing it away impede us. We should actually and deliberately put into practice the greatest Commandment on a daily basis even as the first Commandment becomes more [important] and more a part of us.

More can us a # of separate Psalms, too.

Jesus answered, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.' This is the greatest and the most important commandment. The second most important commandment is like it: 'Love you neighbor as you love yourself.' The whole Law of Moses and the teachings of the prophets depend on these two commandments."
